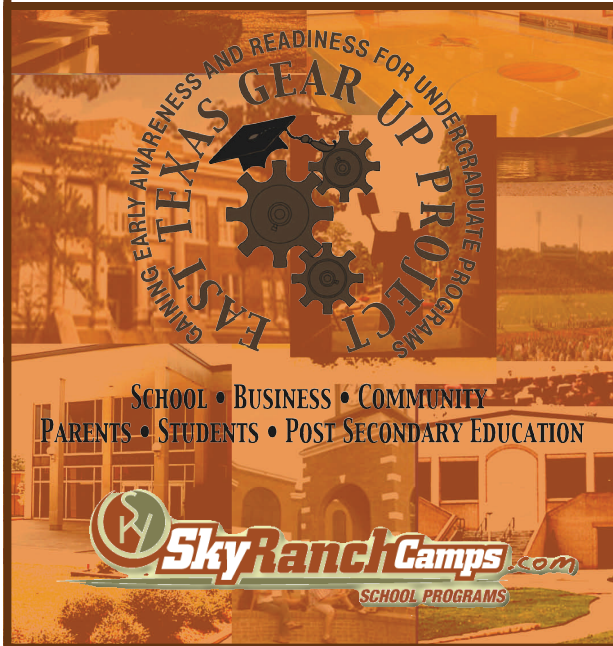

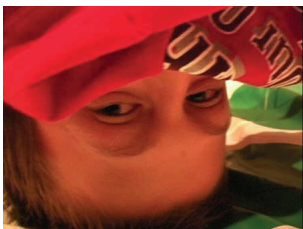
College Scene Investigation



College Scene Investigation (CSI) Agent Certification

Training Overview

The CSI Unit was formed to determine the cause of death of the dreams of students who are no longer enrolled in college. CSI is currently looking for daring individuals who are willing to join the CSI Unit and become a CSI agent to help find missing students. Cadets who attend CSI training will work with CSI agents to solve CSI case files.



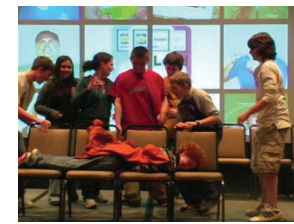
Special Ops Training – CSI agents must have the ability to think creatively and analytically to solve cases. They must be able to work as a team to search for evidence and then process the information in order to solve cases. This training session will engage cadets in a variety of team challenges designed to help the group work as a team and think creatively.

College Culture – Retention research indicates students who do not plug in to the campus culture within the first six weeks of school are less likely to return to school the following semester. This course is designed to introduce cadets to campus life including topics such as residence hall living, student organizations, student activities, campus traditions and campus demographics. The training session consists of an exciting 30 minute video from SkyWay Studios followed by a 30 minute round table discussion with college students, providing highlights of their campus culture.



Career Science – Many students fail in college because they are not adequately prepared to handle the academic challenges college presents. Some enter college without the academic preparation needed to succeed. Others enter without a commitment to a career path and wander from college major to college major accumulating credit hours that do not lead to a college degree. This session will train cadets how to design a college degree plan and how to evaluate an academic transcript to determine the success rate of a student targeting a degree. The course will also train cadets to use various academic support services available on campus to ensure academic success.

Campus Navigation – Students often do not succeed in college because they do not know how to find the right resources. This course consists of a small group session where cadets learn how to navigate a college catalog and how to read a campus map. The session concludes with a campus scavenger hunt.



Explosives – There are many pitfalls along the way to securing a college degree. Some dreams are blown apart before students even reach the college campus. Once on campus, there are many non-academic reasons students fail to achieve their goal. This training session explores the many ways students can get off track and enter a mine field of dangers which can end a college career.

Case Files – Once cadets have finished their training, they must pass their certification exam to become official CSI agents. The examination involves each group taking on a series of case files from students no longer in college and determining the cause of departure.

CSI Agent Certification – All CSI cadets who pass their case files exam will receive an official CSI Agent Certification and staff shirt.
